1. Purpose of Report

To ask Council to appoint two members as Trustees of the Stockburn Memorial Trust

Council is recommended to make two appointments to the Trust

The Stockburn Memorial Trust provides small grants mainly to older people living on a minimum income to help them with living costs, and also helps fund organisations such as Food Banks, Age UK and Homestart in their work with this same client group.

They have requested that the Council appoints two people to its Trustee Board, which currently consist of five people. Cllr Maggie Don was appointed by the former Borough Council and her term of office expires in April. She is willing to be re-appointed.

The Trustees meet twice a year in person. The term of office would be for four years.
