Please find below, information in relation to the Local Nature Recovery Strategy that is being developed by North Northamptonshire Council. The Nene Rivers Trust is working in partnership with both the North and West Northamptonshire Councils to engage and consult with stakeholders and interested parties.

Together with Nature – developing a strategy for nature recovery in Northamptonshire.

A Local Nature Recovery Strategy is being developed by North and West Northamptonshire Council with the help of local people and representatives living and working in the landscape. Local Nature Recovery Strategies will set priorities for nature recovery by identifying habitats and species which are important to conserve and seek opportunities where biodiversity can be increased.

Nene Rivers Trust, as part of the engagement process have created a number of events to invite people and organisations to feed into the development of the strategies. This includes an online workshop event specifically for Parish Council representatives. This will be held on **Thursday, 20th June at 4.30pm – 6pm**. This workshop is for Parish clerks and representatives who are interested to hear more about Local Nature Recovery plans and directly influence the content of the emerging strategy.
